London Olympics 2012

The 2012 Summer Olympic Games began in London, United Kingdom, on 27 July and will continue until 12 August 2012. Around 10,500 athletes from 204 National Olympic Committees are expected to participate. London is the first city to officially host the modern Olympic Games three times, having previously done so in 1908 and in 1948.



Construction in preparation for the Games has involved considerable redevelopment, particularly themed towards sustainability. The main focus of this is a new 200-hectare Olympic Park, constructed on a former industrial site at Stratford in the east of London.



The official mascots for the 2012 Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games are Mandeville (left) and Wenlock (right) which are animations depicting two drops of steel from a steelworks in Bolton.



Approximately 4,700 Olympic and Paralympic medals have been produced by the Royal Mint. Each medal weighs 375-400g. The obverse, as is traditional, features Nike, the Greek goddess of victory, the reverse features the Games logo. The medals were transferred to the Tower of London vaults on 2 July 2012 for storage.
